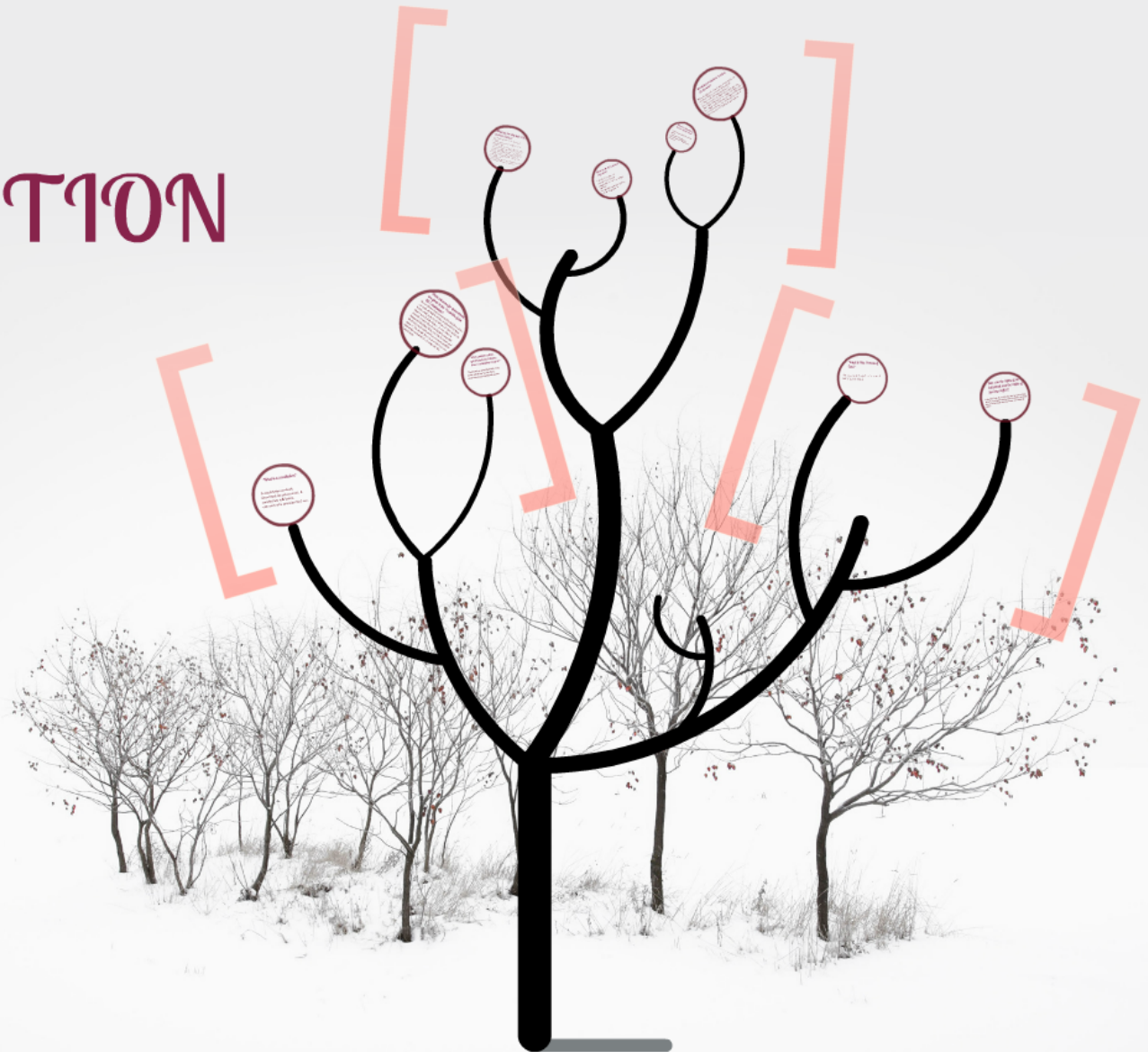


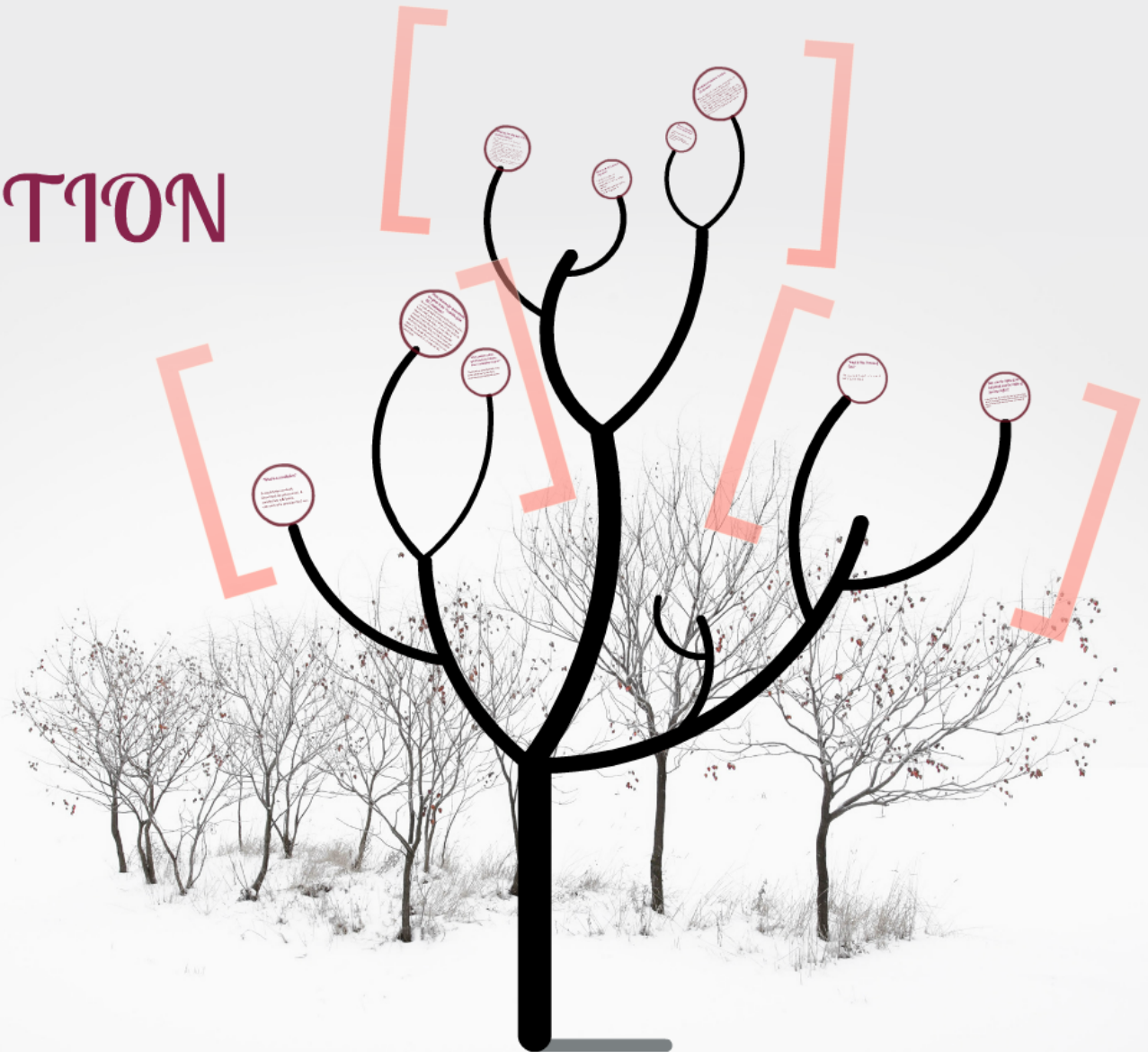

What are five characteristics of a constitution?

1. It sets basic rights of citizens in life, liberty and property.
2. It establishes the responsibility of government to protect these rights.
3. It gives limits on how the people or government or any one of them operate. Under a right of law and constitution limits the power of government and citizens.
4. It establishes the structure of government and how the powers should be divided among the executive, legislative and judiciary.
5. It should be observed with the willing and consent of citizens and it should be supreme and permanent.

What are the 4 freedoms of Expression?

2. the freedom of press
3. right of the people peacefully to assemble
4. petition the government for a redress of grievances

Should there be limits to Freedom of Expression?

When the right to freedom of expression is a particular problem in relation to public safety or national security or when there is a serious threat to the public order or the national interest. The right to a free press might conflict with national security. The freedom of expression should be limited by the government.

What are five characteristics of a constitution?

1. It lists basic rights of citizens to life, liberty, and property.
2. It established the responsibility of government to protect those rights.
3. It places limits on how the people in government may use their powers. Some example of how our constitution limits the powers of government are: Citizen's rights; How resources are distributed; How conflicts are handled.
4. It establishes the principle of a private domain. A private domain is that part of a person/s life that is not business of government.
5. It can only be changed with the widespread consent of citizens and according to certain set procedures.

Should there be limits to Freedom of Expression?

When the right to freedom of expression in a particular situation is dangerous to public safety, national security, or some other important interest.

Also, when one person's right to freedom of expression may conflict with someone else's rights. The right to a free press might conflict with someone's right to a fair trial in a court of law. For these two situations the freedom of expression should be limited by the government.

What is Due Process of Law?

due process is the right to be treated fairly by government.
